9 A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A MAINTENANCE
10 AGREEMENT WITH AKDOT ACCEPTING MAINTENANCE RESPONSIBILITIES FOR THE
11 THE NEW ASPHALT PATHWAY CONSTRUCTED UNDER THE ALASKA TRANSPORTATION
12 ALTERNATIVES PROGRAM GROWDEN AREA ACCESSIBILITY IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

14 WHEREAS, The State of Alaska, Department of Transportation and Public
15 Facilities (AKDOT) is scheduled to complete a pathway development project through
16 Kiwanis, Growden, and Ringstad Parks from Second Avenue to Stewart Street through
17 the Alaska Transportation Alternatives Program (ATAP); and
18

19 WHEREAS, The Fairbanks North Star Borough (Borough) is the owner of
20 Kiwanis, Growden, and Ringstad Parks; and
21

22 WHEREAS, Pathways and Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) access
23 within and between these parks and local attractions do not exist and park users and
24 pedestrians frequently use parking lots and unmarked street crossings for access in
25 these areas; and
26

27 WHEREAS, The Growden Area Accessibililty Improvements project includes
28 accessible bicycle and pedestrian paths connecting Kiwanis, Growden, and Ringstad
29 Parks and will greatly improve public safety and ADA access to park facilities and the
30 surrounding area for Borough residents and visitors and establish designated
31 crosswalks; and

33 WHEREAS, The AKDOT requires a maintenance agreement be entered
34 into with the Borough before beginning construction of this project.
35

36 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Assembly of the Fairbanks
37 North Star Borough that the Mayor, or his delegate, is hereby authorized to execute and
38 sign on behalf of the Fairbanks North Star Borough, a Maintenance Agreement between
39 the Fairbanks North Star Borough and the State of Alaska, Department of
40 Transportation and Public Facilities for the pathways completed by the ATAP Growden
41 Area Accessibility Improvements Project.
