9 A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE STATE OF ALASKA DEPARTMENT OF
10 TRANSPORTATION AND PUBLIC FACILITIES NORTHERN REGION'S APPLICATION FOR
11 COMMUNITY TRANSPORTATION PROGRAM PROJECTS

13 WHEREAS, The Community Transportation Program (CTP) is administered
14 by the State of Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities (ADOT&PF)
15 and is designed to bring roadway improvements to communities and areas outside of
16 Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) boundaries; and
17

18 WHEREAS, The deadline for 2019 CTP applications was extended to allow
19 for more applications to be submitted for consideration; and
20

21 WHEREAS, The CTP is a competitive grant program and acquiring letters
22 and resolutions of support from local stakeholders increases the likelihood of a project
23 being selected for funding; and
24

25 WHEREAS, The ADOT&PF Northern Region office will be proposing three
26 CTP projects: Johnson Road reconstruction; Chena Pump Road and Chena Ridge Road
27 rehabilitation; and the Steese Highway milepost 41-52 reconstruction; and
28

29 WHEREAS, The proposed projects are within the Fairbanks North Star
30 Borough (Borough) and outside of the MPO boundary; and
31

32 WHEREAS, The FNSB Regional Comprehensive Plan, Transportation and
33 Infrastructure Goal 1 is "To have a safe, efficient, multi-modal transportation system
34 that anticipates community growth" and an implementation strategy for that goal is to
35 "Encourage location, design and maintenance of roads based on their function and
36 community needs;" and
37

38 WHEREAS, It is in the best interest of the Borough to support the
39 proposed CTP projects because they are squarely aligned with the Borough's
40 Comprehensive Plan.

42 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Assembly of the Fairbanks
43 North Star Borough supports the Alaska Department of Transportation and Public

44 Facilities – Northern Region’s Community Transportation Program application for the
45 Johnson Road reconstruction project, Chena Pump Road and Chena Ridge Road
46 rehabilitation project, and the Steese Highway milepost 41-52 reconstruction project.
