9 A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE DONATION/TRANSFER OF SURPLUS PROPERTY (AIR  
10 QUALITY MONITORING EQUIPMENT) IN EXCESS OF \$1,000 TO THE STATE OF ALASKA  
11 DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION (ADEC)  
12

13 WHEREAS, The Fairbanks North Star Borough (Borough) and ADEC share  
14 joint responsibilities regarding the Fairbanks North Star Borough PM2.5 non-attainment  
15 area with specific details contained in Memorandum of Understanding (MOU)  
16 established between the two agencies; and  
17

18 WHEREAS, The Borough was lead agency for regulatory ambient air  
19 monitoring, which included maintenance and operation of the federally required air  
20 quality monitoring network until July 1, 2016; and  
21

22 WHEREAS, As of July 1, 2016, ADEC became lead agency for regulatory  
23 ambient air monitoring and assumed maintenance and operation of the federally  
24 required air quality monitoring network consisting of three sampling sites in the  
25 Borough; and  
26

27 WHEREAS, The air quality monitoring equipment detailed in the inventory  
28 list (Attachment A) was used by the Borough to fulfill the regulatory air quality  
29 monitoring requirements; and  
30

31 WHEREAS, ADEC continues to use the air quality monitoring equipment  
32 detailed in the attached inventory list to fulfill the regulatory air quality monitoring  
33 requirements; and  
34

35 WHEREAS, The Borough continues to operate and maintain a low cost  
36 non-regulatory neighborhood monitoring program with the primary purpose to provide  
37 local schools and the general public with real time PM2.5 data for decision making; and  
38

39 WHEREAS, None of the equipment on the inventory list is used to operate  
40 the FNSB neighborhood monitoring program.  
41

42 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Assembly of the Fairbanks  
43 North Star Borough determines it is in the best interest of the Borough to transfer the

44 air quality monitoring equipment detailed in the inventory list (Attachment A) to ADEC  
45 for the following reasons:

- 47 1. This transfer of air quality equipment will allow ADEC to continue  
48 uninterrupted operation and maintenance of the regulatory air quality  
49 monitors.
  - 50 2. The Fairbanks North Star Borough will continue to benefit from ADEC's  
51 use of this equipment as the data collected is used to show progress in  
52 PM2.5 mitigation efforts.
