14 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FY 2019-20 BUDGET BY APPROPRIATING \$83,333 IN
15 FEDERAL PASS-THROUGH FUNDING TO THE SPECIAL REVENUE FUND TO COVER
16 ELIGIBLE ALASKA REGIONAL DEVELOPMENT ORGANIZATIONS (ARDOR) EXPENSES
17 AND PROVIDE INFORMATION AND TECHNICAL EXPERTISE TO LOCAL BUSINESSES
18 REGARDING FUNDING OPPORTUNITIES

20 WHEREAS, The Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES
21 Act) was signed into law by the President on March 27, 2020; and
22

23 WHEREAS, Title V, Section 5001 of the CARES Act amended the Social
24 Security Act to add a new Title VI, Section 601 which established a \$150 billion
25 Coronavirus Relief Fund (CRF) for payments to States, Tribal governments and units of
26 local governments; and
27

28 WHEREAS, The Alaska Legislature accepted the State of Alaska’s \$1.25
29 billion allotment of CARES Act CRF dollars; and
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31 WHEREAS, \$750,000 of the State’s CRF dollars have been allocated to the
32 Alaska Regional Development Organizations (ARDORs) and will be distributed by the
33 Alaska Department of Commerce, Community, and Economic Development (DCCED); and
34

35 WHEREAS, Each ARDOR is authorized to receive funding not to exceed
36 \$83,333; and
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38 WHEREAS, The Fairbanks North Star Borough Economic Development
39 Commission is the designated ARDOR for the Interior Alaska region; and
40

41 WHEREAS, CARES Act relief funds may only be spent on expenditures
42 related to the COVID-19 public health emergency; and

43 WHEREAS, The Borough intends to use funds to cover eligible expenses and
44 provide information and technical expertise to local businesses regarding funding
45 opportunities; and

46
47 WHEREAS, If technical assistance and marketing expenditures are less than
48 estimated, then the remaining portion of the funding will be allocated to offset the cost
49 of the FNSB business grant program administration, at the direction of the Administration;
50 and

52 WHEREAS, The Administration intends to evaluate and secure external
53 contractor(s) to provide business grant program administration, marketing, and business
54 technical assistance; and

56 WHEREAS, Use of these funds for this purpose is specifically prescribed as
57 part of the fund acceptance agreement and will help supplement funds being used to
58 support these new programs to allow for more funding to be distributed as grants into
59 the community.

60
61 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Assembly of the Fairbanks
62 North Star Borough:

63
64 Section 1. Classification. This ordinance is not of a general and
65 permanent nature and shall not be codified.

66
67 Section 2. Acceptance of Federal Pass-Through Funding. The Fairbanks
68 North Star Borough formally accepts the estimated \$83,333 in federal funding from the
69 CARES Act, passed through DCCED for eligible expenses.

70
71 Section 3. Special Revenue Fund Appropriation. They FY 2019-20 budget
72 is hereby amended by appropriating \$83,333 to the Special Revenue Fund budgetary
73 guideline entitled "ARDOR CARES Act Funding" and by increasing estimated revenue from
74 federal pass-through funds by a like amount.

75
76 Section 4. Contingency. This appropriation is contingent upon the
77 receipt of a signed and executed agreement with DCCED.


78
79 Section 5. Indirect Fee Waiver. Indirect fees are waived in accordance
80 with the provisions of the CARES Act CRF funding.

81
82 Section 6. Provision for Appropriation. This appropriation is for an
83 estimated amount. The actual amount of the financial assistance will be appropriated
84 contingent, and based upon, the signed agreement. Any material differences, as
85 determined by the Chief Financial Officer, will be communicated to the Assembly.

86 Section 7. Eligible Expenditure Period. Expenditures incurred within the
87 effective dates of the signed agreement with DCCED are eligible for reimbursement.
88

89 Section 8. Effective Date. This ordinance is effective immediately upon
90 adoption.

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
